OUR COURSES

Our courses are structured according to the Council of Europe's *Common European Framework of Reference for Languages*. Students not previously enrolled in the *IIC* who wish to follow a course at a higher level are advised to take an assessment test (free of charge). Level A1.1 is for total beginners and those students with a very basic knowledge of Italian. No test is necessary.

Our courses will help you develop speaking, reading and writing skills in a structured and gradual manner. Our teachers are Italian graduates with extensive experience and special qualifications in the teaching of Italian as a foreign language. Their enthusiasm and ability is known throughout Dublin and beyond.
